





























The Guardian – Mullah Omar's obituary

A fanatic and recluse who hardly ever met outsiders and knew little of the world at large, he was perhaps best known as the man who gave asylum to the equally fanatical Saudi Arabian founder of al-Qaida, Osama bin Laden. And it was from the safe haven of Afghanistan that Bin Laden ordered the attack on the World Trade Center in New York on 11 September 2001 that killed nearly 3,000 people."

The current crisis is some forty years in the making. A monarchy ruled the country until 1973. In the decade that followed, competing political actors tried to seize control of the country, aided by various foreign powers. The Soviet Union backed leftist revolutionaries who had seized power in a coup in 1978. From 1979, the U.S., in turn, supported a number of resistance groups who called themselves mujahidin. Pakistan, Iran, Saudi Arabia and other countries joined in supporting the mujahidin, while several million Afghans had to flee the country. At least a million Afghans died in the bloody struggle for control of Afghanistan.
